Submission Instructions

Pennsylvania Society of Anesthesiologists - Lightning Poster Presentations

Lightning Poster Presentations focus on one key point. This can be an idea, a successful project, a cautionary tale, a collaboration invitation, a quick tip, or demonstration. It is an opportunity for ideas to get the attention they deserve, within a maximum of 3 minutes. The clock will be ticking, so get prepared!

Proposals are limited to 400 words and no longer than one page using 10-point Arial font. Lightning Poster Presentations will be a maximum of 1 minute each. Presenters may use a single electronic poster or slide for the presentation.

Lightning Poster Proposal Format and Contents

The proposal is limited to 1 page, 500 words max. in PDF format and should include the following:

- Title: A title for the Lightning Presentation.
- Abstract: A summary of the Lightning Presentation.
- Description: Describe your talk in more detail. It will be helpful for reviewers to know why you are excited about the topic, and why you think others will be interested too. Outline how you plan to present your topic in 3 minutes.
- Submissions must be in English.

Lightning Poster Proposal Submission

By submitting your proposal, you agree to register for the PSA Annual Meeting and present in person if it is selected for presentation during the PSA Annual Meeting on **March 4, 2023**, in Lafayette Hill, PA. Submissions will not be evaluated unless the primary presenter has registered for the meeting.

Lightning Poster Proposal Evaluation

Proposals will be evaluated on a scale of 1 to 10 for the following criteria:

- How informative is the title and does it match up with the abstract content?
- Is the proposal a good summary of the topic being discussed?
- Is the proposal an indicator for an interesting lightning talk?
- Is the proposal written in a way that makes the topic accessible to an audience with diverse interests?

After review by the evaluation panel, Lightning Poster Proposals will be chosen to be presented on the day of the meeting and the primary presenter will be notified by **February 1, 2023**.

Lightning Poster Presentations

- Posters must be submitted in .pdf format with the highest resolution possible.
- Posters must be in wide-screen format, 16:9 aspect ratio.
- Posters will be displayed electronically at the meeting.
- For easier readability, we recommend arranging information blocks like:

- The poster should be a self-contained document that does not lead to additional content hosted elsewhere. Video content may not be included as part of a poster. Do not include links to video or other content.

Submission Instructions

Lightning Poster Presentations will take place on **March 4, 2023 at Layfayette Hill, PA**. The criteria for judging on the day of the meeting include:

- Content/Narrative-clear narrative flow, thesis/take away message is communicated in the allotted time of 1 minute.
- Presentation Style- poster is relevant and clear, the presentation can be understood by a general audience. Speaker is engaging.
- Engaging presentation and staying within the time limit of 1 minute is critical!
- **Best Lightning Poster Presentation will receive \$100 prize.**
