

Staff Risk Stratification for the care of Suspected or Confirmed COVID-19 Patient

The following risk stratification survey is derived internally. It is based upon CDC and WHO recommendations, along with data coming from high exposure areas.

This has not been scientifically validated; however, it is our best attempt to protect our department during this pandemic, while at the same time maintaining your privacy.

Utilizing the following scoring system, we aim to reduce the risk of exposure for staff with the following, from caring for a confirmed or suspected COVID-19

- 1) <60 y.o. with *two or more* chronic health conditions
- 2) >60 y.o. with *one or more* chronic health conditions
- 3) If you are 60-70 y.o. you must have NO chronic health conditions to care for COVID-19 + patients

Automatic exclusions for direct patient care of the confirmed or suspected patient are:

- Pregnancy
- the immunocompromised
- >70 years old

The scores will be utilized as prioritization of requests for time off from work during this pandemic. Additionally, for those with total scores of 4 or more, all attempts will be made to prevent exposure to suspected or confirmed patients.

| Criteria | Value Your score |
|-------------------------------------------|------------------|
| 60-70 years old | 2 |
| Chronic Lung Disease | 2 |
| Cardiovascular disease | 2 |
| Caregiver to elderly or immunocompromised | 2 |
| Diabetic | 2 |
| 50-60 years old | 1 |
| Primary caregiver to child under 6mos. | 1 |
